News on the upcoming changes at Bridgeport Hospital School of Nursing:

Bridgeport Hospital School of Nursing, BHSN, has admitted its last graduating class the fall of 2015 to graduate May, 2017. The accelerated class will graduate in December, 2016. The academic final year at BHSN remains strong, current and continues to uphold quality education. The program has enhanced students' knowledge and clinical application of safety initiatives with a focus on high reliability organizations (HRO). This spring the School began a Safety & Quality bulletin sent to students emphasizing key principles of clinical practice. BHSN has also enriched the area of "Diversity" within the curriculum to reflect current trends in healthcare. The School is strong and will end strong!

The RN to BSN program began its first class the fall of 2015, at the University of Bridgeport (UB), and the traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing, BSN, degree program has started this fall, 2016 also at UB. A majority of faculty from BHSN have remained at the school to teach the last class, few have transitioned to UB, and most will join the UB BSN nursing program by July, 2017. The BHSN has taught nursing students since 1884 and has accomplished graduate nurses whom have exceeded the national average on the NCLEX-RN state board of examination. The graduates of BHSN have had strong clinical experiences and have been held in the highest regard. This will end the 133 year diploma nursing program at Bridgeport Hospital School of Nursing, which is the last program of its kind in CT. The BSN program is the upcoming way of the future for nursing by 2020. The BHSN website has been totally changed and now addresses the current changes and the changes to come.
